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Abstract

Analysis of moral humanity in film Skyscraper is a study that explains the moral message. In this study, of course, using a qualitative descriptive research method, namely researchers will make direct observations of moral messages. The research object used by researchers is An Analysis of Moral Humanity in Rawson Marshall Thurbers Skyscraper Film. Where this film was produced by Beau Flynn directed by Rawson Marshall Thurbers because it tells about phenomena inherent in everyday life such as kinship, responsibility, courage, mutual trust, love, help, and honesty. The data collection technique used in this study was documentation analysis. Where the researcher captures several scenes that contain moral messages to be conveyed to the public. The results found in this film based on the theory of Roland Barthes are to analyze the meaning of signifiers, denotative, connotative, and mythical meanings. The results of this study show 7 scenes that show elements of the moral message in the Skyscraper film. So the researchers found the hidden meaning of the film in the form of a moral message.

1. Introduction

The development of Science and Technology in this day and age is growing very rapidly in all fields, including in the field of literature (film). Literature is the author's reflection on life and life combined with the power of imagination and creation which is supported by his experiences and observations of that life. One of the goals of the presence of literature in the midst of society is to strive to increase human dignity as cultural, thinking and godly creatures. Film is the

development of drama literary works which are then visualized into a complete story by actors and actresses. Apart from being a popular source of entertainment, films are a medium for educating, containing moral messages and giving teachings to the public. Films function as a medium of information and social documents. Endraswara (2016:9). Film has its own artistic value, because film is created as a work of creative professionals who are professionals in their fields. Film as an object of art should be assessed

artistically, not rationally. Film studies can be said to be a relatively new field of study and is not comparable to the process of technological evolution. Semiotics is a scientific study or analytical method to examine signs in a context of scenarios, images, texts, and scenes in films that can be interpreted. Meaning means that objects do not only carry information, in this case the objects want to communicate, but also constitute a structured system of signs used in the film. Mudjiono, (2020:125-138). Message is something conveyed by the communicator to the communicant through the communication process (Tasmara, 1987: 7 in Afan, 2024). Meanwhile, the message in the book Introduction to Communication Science is a series of signs/symbols created by someone for a specific purpose with the hope that the delivery of a sign/symbol will succeed in causing something. Hafid (2004:14). Communication in human life feels very important, because with communication can bridge all forms of ideas that will delivered by someone. In every communication is an important element Among them is the message, because the message is conveyed through the media appropriate, understandable language, simple and appropriate words intent, as well as the purpose of the message will be conveyed and easily digested by communicant. As for the message according to Onong Effendy, states that message is: "a component in the communication process in the form of a combination of thoughts and feelings of a person by using (Auliauraahman, M. 2024).

Moral message in literary works summarized in themes, characters and

elements others that make up a literary work. An important moral message is conveyed to reader of literature. Through a moral message, the author or literary work can convey the good side and bed about life. Teaching morals in literary works are pleasing to the eye as a mandate and a message. Nurgiantoro (2013:430). The moral message is important in every narrative story included in films shown on the big screen. Message Moral is a moral lesson or message that can be obtained from an event, someone's experience, or from a film that can provide life lessons for the audience and for others (Apriansyah, 2018 in Afan, 2023).

In making literary works, authors always use a strong imagination to create a new literary work. literature is an expression of human thoughts and feelings both verbally and in writing (print), using beautiful language according to the context. Caulton (2012: 2-8).

Researchers are interested in researching this film because apart from having a good story, this film can also motivate the audience to act like the story being acted out. Apart from being motivating, this film also contains a lot of moral messages for humanity, one of which is kinship providing entertainment to audiences but also presenting messages educating which is now rarely shown in Indonesian films "Skyscraper " is included in a quality film and educative in terms of visual and in terms of content. Messages in a film when done well and interesting will give the impression that the audience is easy to understand and draw conclusions from the film. Almost all movies teach or tell the audience about something, because with watching movies audiences can learn how to get along with

people others, behavior, appearance and soon. The research questions that stated are what is the moral message in Rawson Marshall Thurber's Skyscraper?, what is the moral impact of humanity in the skyscraper film for the audiences?

2. Research Method

The research method that will be used in describing the moral messages in the film Skyscraper by Rawson Marshall Thurber is a descriptive qualitative method with document analysis which aims to make a systematic, factual and accurate description. Qualitative method as a research procedure that produces descriptive data in the form of written or spoken words and written data from people's observable behavior (Moleong, 2006:4 in Afan,2024). Procedure of data collection by measuring and analyzing accurate insights for the problem at hand using validated engineering standards. In this research, the researcher used semiotics theory of Roland Barthes to analyze denotative and connotative to identify the humanity moral message in Skyscraper film, then analyzed the movie based on the picture in the scenes of the Film with some steps; Purchase Skyscraper film file, download Skyscraper film, Watching the film repeatedly to find out the human messages found in the Skyscraper film. Collect data from books, journals related to the film. Collect related theories to the research to be studied.

3. Findings and Discussion

a. Moral Message.

In conducting this research, the message conveyed by the researcher to the audience contains a moral message. The moral message is an idea about the good and bad teachings of actions and


behavior that the film maker wants to convey to the audience. Therefore, in this discussion the researcher will discuss the moral message in the Skyscraper film according to the scene category that the researcher has chosen. This is one of the tasks that the researcher has mentioned, which is to make people who see the film want to do the invitation contained in the film.

b. Denotation, Connotation and Myth

Rawson Skyscraper film has a moral message that describes family, responsibility, mutual trust, and courage. The author first explains the reality of the moral message then the meaning of denotation, connotation, and myth from the film.

But Will never regretted all that happened because from this incident he benefited, namely he met Sarah who became his wife and Sarah also taught him good things that could change his life and again he has 2 children who make him love him even more about his family and his principles now family is number one for him no matter what happens he is willing to defend and save his family to the death.
